In order to enable Directors (excluding those who are Executive Directors) to fully perform their expected roles, the Company's Articles of Incorporation stipulate that the Company may enter into agreements with Directors (excluding those who are Executive Directors) to limit their liability for damages due to negligence of their duties, with the maximum amount of liability being the minimum amount stipulated by laws and regulations. The Company has entered into such agreements with Masatake Yone, Katsuichiro Toyoshima, Yoshihiro Miwa and Nobukazu Asai, and if their reelection is approved, the Company plans to continue the agreements with them.
- 3. The Company has entered into a directors and officers liability insurance policy with an insurance company, as stipulated in Article 430-3, paragraph (1) of the Companies Act, in which Directors, Audit & Supervisory Board Members, and Executive Officers of the Company are insured. The said insurance policy shall cover the legally mandated amount of indemnification and litigation expenses that the insured would otherwise be liable for. Each candidate will be insured in the said insurance policy. The Company plans to renew this insurance policy with the same contents at the next renewal.
- 4. Masatake Yone, Katsuichiro Toyoshima, Yoshihiro Miwa, and Nobukazu Asai are candidates for External Directors. The Company has designated Masatake Yone and Katsuichiro Toyoshima as independent directors as stipulated by the Tokyo Stock Exchange and has notified the Tokyo Stock Exchange to that effect. If their reelection is approved, the Company will continue to designate them as independent directors.
- 5. The attendance at Board of Directors meetings of Keisuke Takaki, Takeshi Kiriyama, Katsuichiro Toyoshima, Yoshihiro Miwa, and Nobukazu Asai is for the period after they assumed their positions on June 26, 2024.

- 6. It is planned that Kunio Kusanagi will resign as Manager of Airline Management, Corporate Strategy, ANA HOLDINGS INC., before the start of this Annual General Meeting of Shareholders.
- 7. Yamaha Motor Co., Ltd., where Masatake Yone has been serving as a Corporate Auditor (External) since March 2019, was found to have inappropriate handling of motorcycle testing and certification applications. On June 3, 2024, the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism announced that misconduct had occurred during the submission of applications for model designations and ordered the suspension of shipments for the models involved in the misconduct. Although he was not aware of these facts in advance, Masatake Yone had been making recommendations from various perspectives, including legal compliance, on a regular basis. Following the disclosure of these facts, he has been making recommendations regarding the implementation of thorough investigations, strengthening internal controls to prevent recurrence, and ensuring comprehensive compliance.
