■ Topics

In September, the company achieved a +11.9% year-over-year increase in total sales across all eyewear stores in Japan. Existing stores contributed with a +7.5% year-on-year increase in same-store sales.

The +7.5% year-on-year same-store sales increase was driven by robust seasonal demand spurred by the lingering late-summer heat and continued strong demand from inbound tourism, while the effectiveness of promotional campaigns also helped to boost purchasing motivation.

As of the end of September, the total number of eyewear stores in Japan was 545, representing a net increase of 5 stores.
