### **Notice Concerning Ransomware Incident at Consolidated Subsidiary (Second Report)**

We hereby provide an update concerning the ransomware incident at our local subsidiary in Vietnam, DAINICHI COLOR VIETNAM CO., LTD. (the "Subsidiary"), which was announced on December 17, 2025. The details confirmed as of today are as follows.

We have established a task force and are proceeding with an investigation into the scope of the impact with the cooperation of external specialized companies.

We take this situation very seriously and will continue to proceed with the investigation and recovery, as well as work to strengthen information security to prevent recurrence.

We sincerely apologize for the significant concern and inconvenience this has caused to our customers, business partners, and all other relevant parties.

#### **1. Background**

On December 15, 2025, we confirmed that files on servers and PCs within the Subsidiary's internal system had been encrypted and rendered unreadable. We immediately took emergency measures, such as disconnecting relevant servers and PCs from the network, and have since continued to investigate the scope of the impact with the cooperation of external experts.

#### **2. Scope of Information Affected**

The investigation has revealed that the encrypted electronic data contains the following information, including customer information:

<Information Affected>

- (1) Financial and tax data
- (2) Various reports submitted to government agencies and contract-related documents
- (3) Various documents regarding import/export and customs clearance

Please note that at this time, we have not confirmed any facts indicating that this information has been leaked externally.

3. Impact on Operations and Financial Results

Major operations at the Subsidiary, such as manufacturing and shipping, have not been affected, and operations are continuing as usual.

We expect the impact of this incident on our group's consolidated financial results to be minor. However, should any matters requiring disclosure arise in the future, we will promptly make an announcement.
