Notice regarding Dividend from Surplus Earnings (Dividend Increase)

The Yokohama Rubber Co., Ltd. (hereafter, Yokohama Rubber, or the Company), hereby announces that it resolved at its Board of Directors meeting held on the date of this Notice to pay shareholders a dividend from surplus earnings as shown below with a record date of December 31, 2025.

This matter is scheduled to be submitted to the 150th Ordinary General Meeting of Shareholders scheduled to be held on March 27, 2026.

2. Reasons for raising fiscal 2025 dividend and forecast dividend for fiscal 2026

The Company's basic policy is to maintain stable dividends while securing sufficient internal reserves to support future business development and fortify its management structure. Regarding the dividend for fiscal 2025, the Company's strong financial results in fiscal 2025, ended on December 31, 2025, exceeded management's initial forecasts. In addition, the Yokohama Rubber Group's implementation of its YX2026 medium-term management plan's "Best Alternative Strategy" has produced strong results that are advancing the transformation of the Company's profit structure. Considering its forecast for an increase in free cash flow in fiscal 2026 and its targeted 20% dividend payout ratio, the Board of Directors has resolved to raise the year-end dividend for fiscal 2025 to 86 yen per share, an increase of 34 yen from the previously announced figure.

For the fiscal year ending December 2026, the Board of Directors plans to raise the dividend payout ratio to 30% as it seeks to enhance the return for the Company's shareholders.
