The Company and TOYO INNOVEX Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the "Companies".) will establish GMS Group Co., Ltd. that will become a wholly-owning parent company of the Companies on April 1, 2026, as the proposals for establishing a wholly-owning parent company through a share transfer were approved as originally proposed at the Extraordinary General Meeting of Shareholders of the Company held on January 30, 2026 and the Extraordinary General Meeting of Shareholders of TOYO INNOVEX Co., Ltd. held on the same day, and as necessary procedures have been completed thereafter; and the Companies will become wholly owned subsidiaries.

GMS Group Co., Ltd. (Securities Code: 544A) will be newly listed on the Prime Market of the Tokyo Stock Exchange, Inc. as of the same date. We hereby announce that the Company stocks will be consequently delisted effective March 30, 2026.
