Notice Concerning Resolution of a Damages Lawsuit Through Settlement

CENTRAL SECURITY PATROLS CO., LTD. (the “Company”) hereby announces that, regarding the damages lawsuit previously announced in “Notice Concerning Filing of Damages Lawsuit Against the Company” dated September 12, 2023 (including partial corrections made on the same date), a settlement has been reached. The details are stated below.

1. Course of events from the filing of the lawsuit to the settlement

As of July 18, 2023, the damages lawsuit filed by the counterparty (Aioi Nissay Dowa Insurance Co., Ltd.) based on subrogation in insurance had been under examination at the Tokyo District Court, and a settlement was reached today.

2. Outline of the counterparty to the settlement

3. Details of the settlement

The Company has agreed to pay 400 million yen to Aioi Nissay Dowa Insurance Co., Ltd. and both parties have mutually confirmed that no claims or obligations other than those provided in the settlement exist between them.

4. Future outlook

The impact of the expenses associated with the settlement on the Company’s business results for the fiscal year ending February 28, 2027, will be insignificant.
