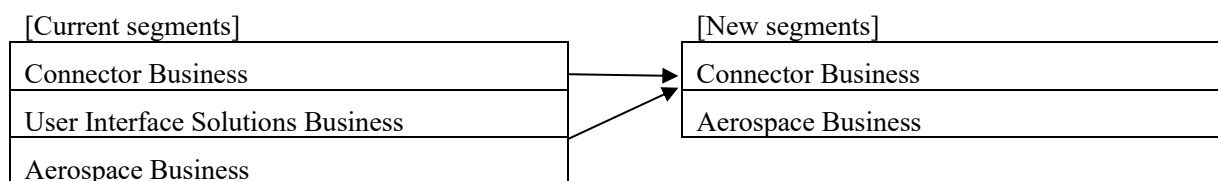
1. Reasons for the Changes

We have conducted our business primarily through three reportable segments of the “Connector Business,” “User Interface Solutions Business,” and “Aerospace Business.”

In the User Interface Solutions Business, we have witnessed a downward trend in its business scale in recent years against the background of shifts in technological trends in the automotive market and the sluggish industrial and infrastructure market. This has resulted in the emergence of inefficiencies in maintaining the function of a separate business segment.

We have recently reviewed our business portfolio and decided to reorganize reporting segments by integrating the “User Interface Solutions Business” into the “Connector Business,” with the aim of driving renewed growth of the business and improving profitability through consolidating management resources to achieve higher efficiency and maximizing synergies in fields with shared customer bases and technologies.
