Notice of difference between non-consolidated financial results of the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 and the results of the previous fiscal year

Tokyo, April 27, 2026—Maxell, Ltd. (TSE: 6810, hereinafter “the Company”) today announced the difference between non-consolidated financial results of the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 and the results of the fiscal year ended March 31, 2025 as follows.

2. Reason for the difference between non-consolidated financial results of the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 and the results of the fiscal year ended March 31, 2025

(Net sales and Operating profit)

Net sales increased in comparison to the previous fiscal year, due to sales increase of primary batteries for medical devices and infrastructure applications and increase of licensing revenues, although sales of prismatic lithium-ion batteries whose production has been discontinued and semiconductor related products decreased. Operating profit increased in comparison to the previous fiscal year, due to improved profit of prismatic lithium-ion batteries and increased licensing revenues, although there were impacts of material cost increase for primary batteries and increased development cost for all-solid-state batteries.

(Ordinary profit and Net profit)

Both ordinary profit and net profit decreased in comparison to the previous fiscal year mainly due to decrease in dividend income from consolidated subsidiaries.
