Revision to the Numerical Targets of the Medium-Term Management Plan

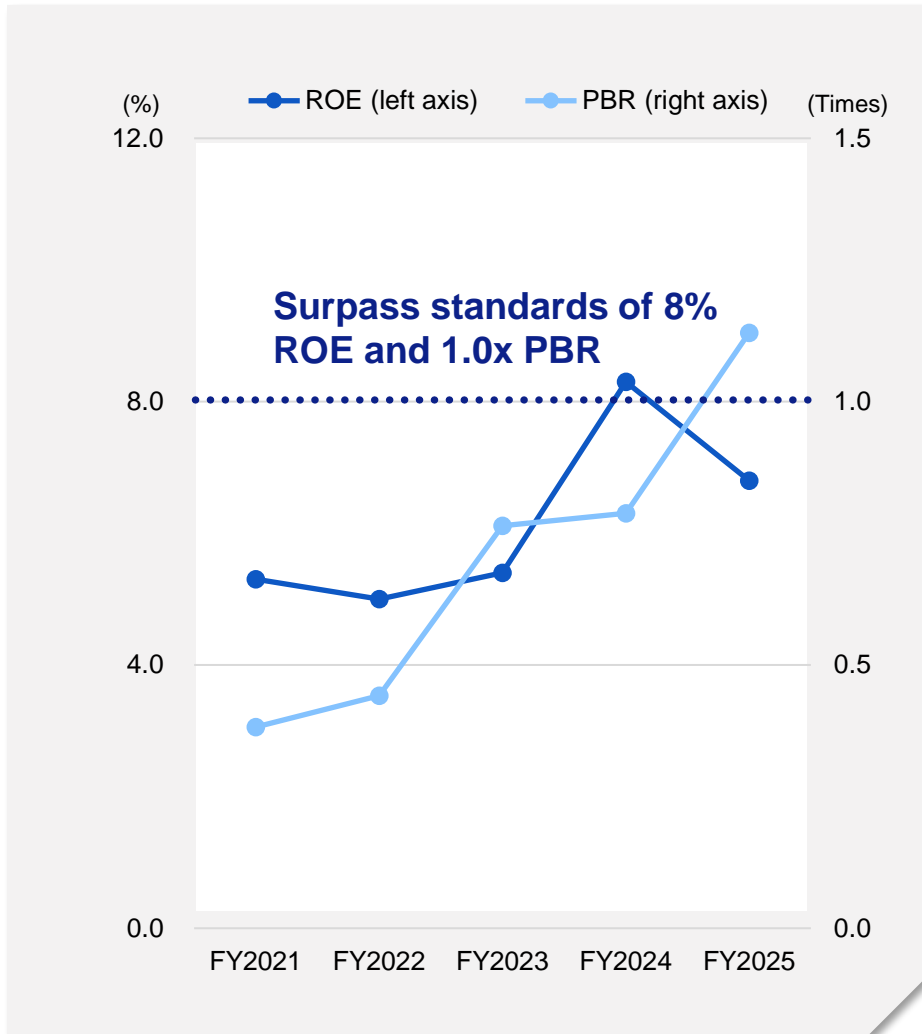
- We have revised the numerical targets of the Medium-Term Management Plan (2024–2028) as shown below to further expand earnings, following partial achievement of the targets (operating profit and ROE)
- We recognize cost of capital to be approximately 5% (based on CAPM) as of October 2025
- We have revised the ROE target to 9.0%, in light of investors' estimate of our cost of capital (in the 6% range) and other factors

Analysis of current status

I ROE has declined due to temporary factors

ROE for the most recent fiscal year (FY2025) has fallen below shareholder capital costs (in the 8% range) due to temporary factors (a decrease in profit due to the recording of extraordinary losses) and an increase in shareholder capital costs as a result of changes in the market environment

Moreover, ROE has fallen below 8%, a level considered the lowest in the market

- We continue to improve profitability and appropriately allocate our management resources to increase our capital efficiency, given that performance excluding one-time factors is in line with our expectations and we expect continued solid performance going forward

I PBR has exceeded 1.0x

PBR has exceeded 1.0x with an increase in the share price, as compared with the previous fiscal year (FY2024) results

- We make continuous efforts to improve profitability
- We enhance our IR activities so that we are evaluated fairly by the market

- Based on our analysis of our current status, we will perform the following actions to implement management that is conscious of cost of capital and stock price

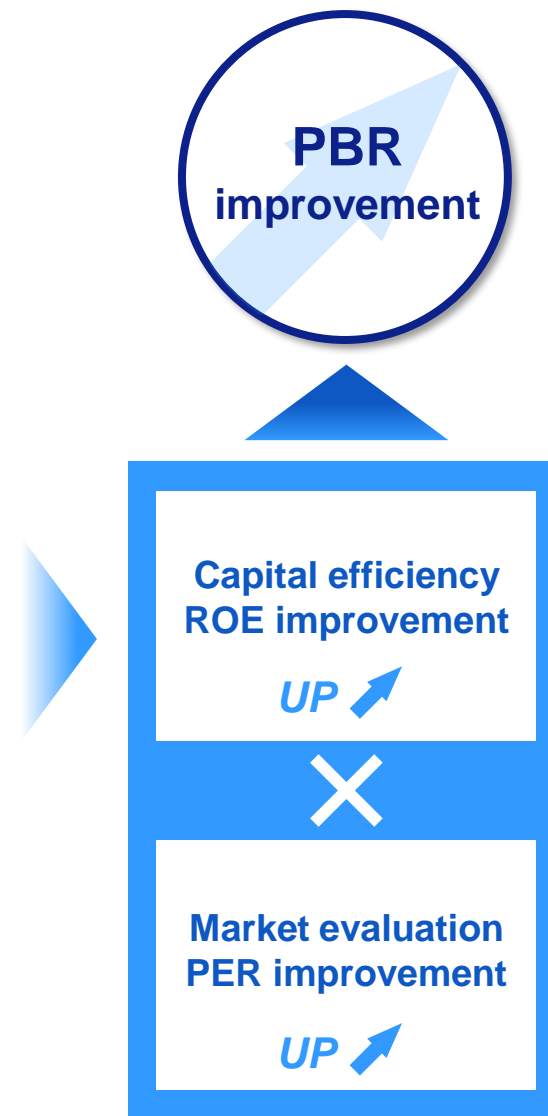
- Implementation of our 2030 Vision and our Medium-Term Management Plan (2024–2028)

- Active growth investment and expanded shareholder returns

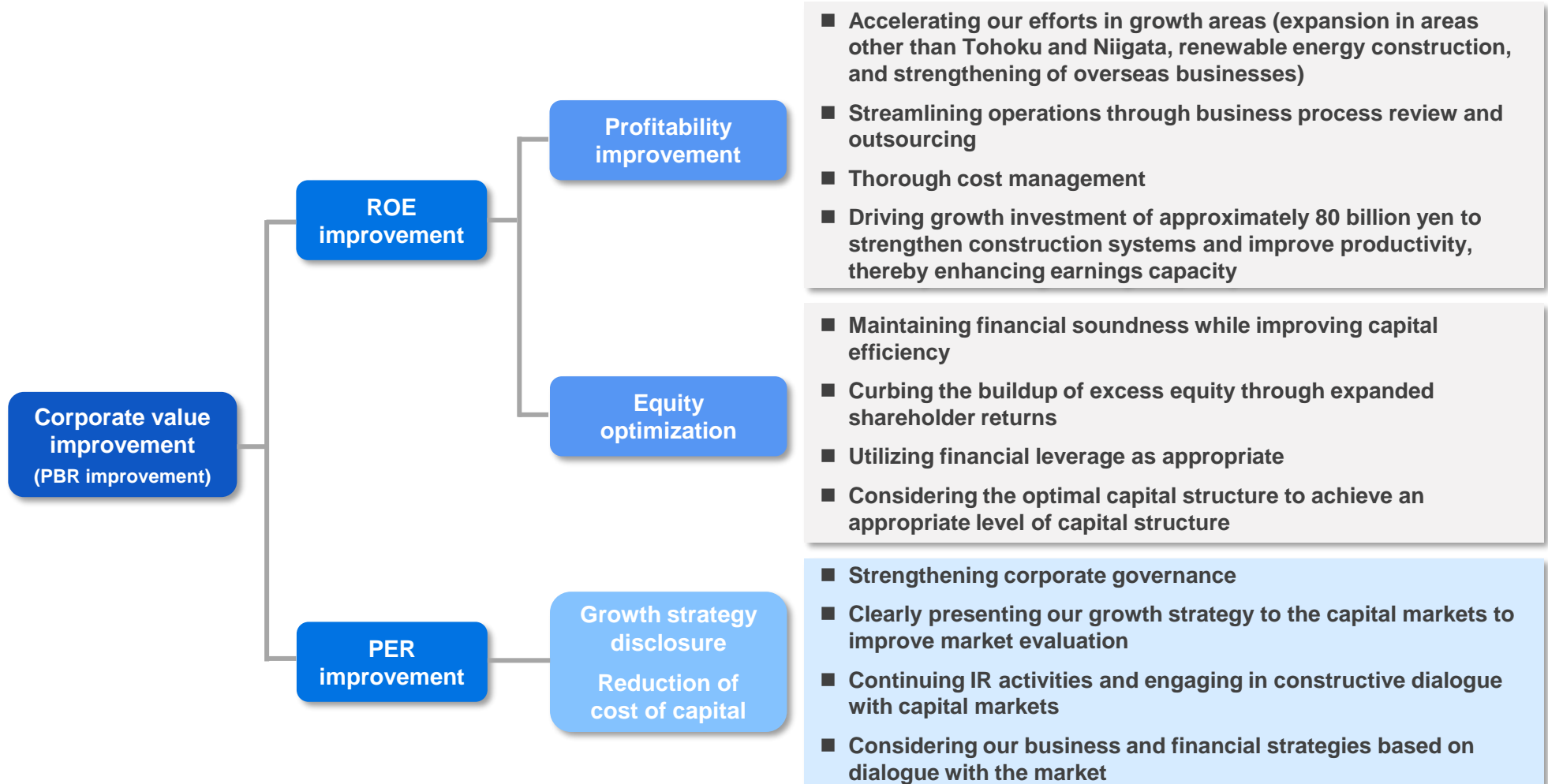

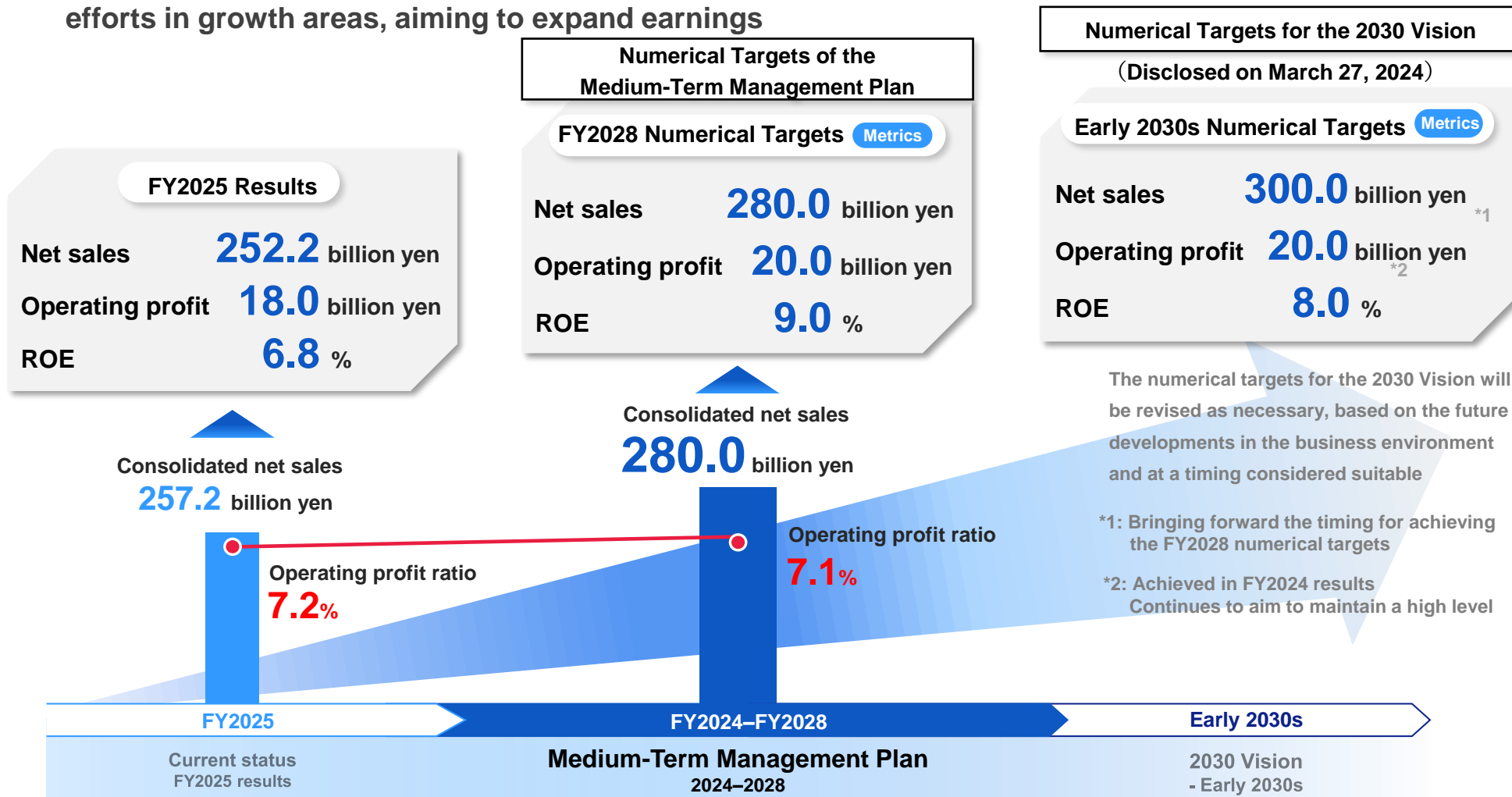
Towards the Improvement of Corporate Value

- We recognize that improving PBR requires improvements in ROE and PER
- We aim to improve ROE through both profitability improvement and capital control, and improve PER by strengthening governance, continuing IR activities, and enhancing information disclosure



1. Profitability Improvement (Progress on the Medium-Term Management Plan)

- We raised the numerical targets of the Medium-Term Management Plan (2024–2028) in October 2025, following partial achievement of the targets (operating profit and ROE) in FY2024
- We will continue to find more business opportunities in existing businesses and accelerate our efforts in growth areas, aiming to expand earnings



1. Profitability Improvement (Four Priority Businesses under the Medium-Term Management Plan)

- Under the Medium-Term Management Plan (2024–2028), we have defined four priority businesses and will improve our profitability in these businesses
- Based on the premise of finding more business opportunities in Tohoku and Niigata—our main areas of business since our foundation—we have defined four priority businesses of ① to ④ shown in the table below, considering business scale and growth in major business areas

- Capital allocation (within the period of the Medium-Term Management Plan 2024–2028)
 - We aim to expand earnings through investments in growth areas totaling **80.0 billion yen**
 - We envision a total return ratio of **50% to 60%** during the Medium-Term Management Plan period
 - We will accelerate growth investments by utilizing operating cash flows as a base, along with financing
