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Notice Concerning the Theft of Electric Cables from Asset Under Management

Canadian Solar Infrastructure Fund, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as “CSIF”) announces that Canadian Solar O&M Japan K.K. (“CSO&M”), to which CSIF outsources O&M services, has reported the theft of electrical cables and the resulting suspension of power generation at the CS Kannami-cho Power Plant owned by CSIF.

According to the report by CSO&M, some of the electric cables at the CS Kannami-cho Power Plant were stolen or otherwise damaged in the evening of May 25, 2026. As a result, a part of the power plant is currently unable to generate electricity.

The above damage has been investigated by the police, and the damage report has been submitted to the police. We are planning to immediately implement emergency measures to restore the power generation system. Details of the restoration work, including measures to prevent recurrence, and an estimate of the final amount of damage will be announced as soon as they are finalized.

Since the CS Kannami-cho Power Plant’s solar module output capacity of 1.336 MW represents only 0.54% of the total CSIF portfolio capacity of 247.571MW, and CSIF is also entitled to receive a basic rent from the lessee equivalent to 70% of the power plant’s forecast monthly rent, the impact of the suspension of power generation on CSIF’s overall rental income is limited. Accordingly, there will be no revision to the forecasts for the fiscal period ending June 2026 (18th fiscal period) or the fiscal period ending December 2026 (19th fiscal period).
