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Notice Concerning Revision to Dividend Forecasts (Dividend Increase)

NAGAILEBEN Co.,Ltd. (the “Company”) resolved at its Board of Directors meeting held on June 29, 2026 to revise the forecast of dividends per share as follows.

1. Reason for revision to dividend forecasts

The Company recognize returning profits to our shareholders as one of our key management priorities, and our basic policy is to continue paying stable dividends, targeting a dividend payout ratio of approximately 50%.

Based on this policy, and after comprehensively considering our business performance and financial condition for the current fiscal year, we have decided to increase our year-end dividend forecast from 60 yen to 70 yen in order to enhance the return of profits to our shareholders.

In addition, our company’s basic policy is to maintain and continue paying dividends at this level on a stable basis, and the Company will strive to enhance our returns to shareholders in line with the sustained growth of our corporate value.

The Company plans to propose this matter on the agenda of its Annual Meeting of Shareholders that is scheduled to be held in November 2026.
