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Notice Concerning Upward Revision of Dividend Forecast

CCReB Advisors Inc. (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”) hereby announces that, at the meeting of its Board of Directors held on July 14, 2026, it resolved to revise upward its dividend forecast for the current fiscal year, as described below.

1. Revision of Dividend Forecast

(1) Reason for Revision

In the announcement titled “Notice Concerning Upward Revision of Earnings Forecast” dated April 14, 2026, the Company stated that, based on its shareholder return policy, the Company would consider flexible measures including dividend increases based on progress in the second half of the fiscal year.

As stated in the financial results for the third quarter of the fiscal year ending August 31, 2026 announced today, business performance has progressed steadily, and the Company expects to achieve its full-year earnings results to be in line with its forecast. Accordingly, in order to further enhance returns to shareholders, the Company has decided to increase the year-end dividend forecast by 3 yen from the previous forecast, revising it to 30 yen per share.
