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Casio Announces Conclusion of Lawsuit for Damages Against Company and its Subsidiary

As announced in the press release dated August 29, 2023, entitled “Casio Announces Filing of Lawsuit for Damages Against Company and its Subsidiary” (in Japanese only), Casio Electronics Co., Ltd. (Address: London, U.K.; Representative: SEIMIYA Takashi; “Casio UK” below), a subsidiary of Casio Computer Co., Ltd., was served with notice of a class action lawsuit filed by plaintiffs represented by Elisabetta Sciallis from the consumer group, Which? (Address: London, U.K.). With the withdrawal of the lawsuit by the plaintiffs, Casio announces its conclusion as follows:

1. Background of Case and Plaintiff’s Claims

Following a ruling that Casio UK had violated competition law by engaging in resale price maintenance (RPM) in the sale of Casio electronic musical instruments in the U.K. between February 2013 and April 2018, a class action lawsuit was filed seeking damages on the grounds that customers had purchased products at unfairly high prices.

It should be noted that the petition was not delivered to Casio Computer Co., Ltd. Only Casio UK, which was served with the petition, became party to the lawsuit.

2. Withdrawal of Lawsuit

The plaintiff’s request to withdraw the lawsuit was granted by the UK Competition Appeal Tribunal, and the lawsuit was concluded on July 13, 2026.

3. Future Outlook

The impact of the conclusion of this lawsuit is immaterial to the consolidated financial performance in the current fiscal year.
