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Withdrawal of Applications for Permits and Approvals for Units 3 and 4 of the Hamaoka Nuclear Power Station and Related Applications

Chubu Electric Power Co., Inc. (the “Company”) submitted applications to the Nuclear Regulation Authority for permits to amend the reactor installation licenses for Units 3 and 4 of the Hamaoka Nuclear Power Station and related applications* in connection with the new regulatory standards and has since been undergoing reviews by the Nuclear Regulation Authority to confirm compliance with the new regulatory standards.

However, since the Company announced inappropriate matters relating to the formulation of the design basis ground motion in the review of conformity with new regulatory standards at the Hamaoka Nuclear Power Station (as previously announced on January 5, 2026) (the “Matter”), the Nuclear Regulation Authority has been conducting regulatory inspections. In addition, on September 11, 2026, the Company received the investigation report from the Independent Committee.

Based on the investigation report of the Independent Committee, the Company determined that, given the serious doubts that have arisen regarding the reliability of the application documents and the Company’s subsequent handling of matters in the review process, it would not be appropriate to maintain the existing applications. Accordingly, at an extraordinary meeting of the Board of Directors held today, the Company resolved to withdraw the applications for permits to amend the reactor installation licenses for Units 3 and 4 of the Hamaoka Nuclear Power Station and related applications, all of which were submitted in connection with the new regulatory standards.

The Company plans to submit the withdrawal documents to the Nuclear Regulation Authority as soon as preparations are complete.

The Company once again sincerely apologizes for betraying the trust of local residents and society at large and for causing significant concern and inconvenience in connection with the Matter.

To regain the trust of all stakeholders, the Company will take the findings of the Independent Committee with the utmost seriousness and sincerity, and with the entire Company working as one, make every effort to fully implement measures to prevent recurrence.

The impact of the matter on the Company’s consolidated financial results for the current fiscal year and future periods has not yet been determined. Should any matters requiring disclosure arise in the future, the Company will promptly announce them.

* Applications for permits to amend the reactor installation licenses for Units 3 and 4 of the Hamaoka Nuclear Power Station, and the application for approval of the construction plan and the application for approval to amend the operational safety program for Unit 4, all of which were submitted in connection with the new regulatory standards
